

ADOPT A FIRE HYDRANT

VOLUNTEER POSITION

Help keep fire hydrants clear of snow and ice so fire trucks can have access in case of an emergency. This volunteer position is available through the Plymouth Fire Department.

TIME COMMITMENT:

- As needed during snowy winter months.

ACTIVITIES/DUTIES:

- Remove significant snow and ice in a three-foot radius around the fire hydrant within 24 hours of occurrence of a snow event.
- Register your hydrant with the Adopt a Spot program so your hydrant and volunteer commitment can be recorded.
- Report any damage or repairs needed to at plymouthmn.gov/myPlymouth or by using the myPlymouth app, which is available from the Google Play and Apple app stores.

QUALIFICATIONS/DESIRED SKILLS:

- Desire to support the City's fire department and emergency response personnel.
- Willing to follow through on a commitment.
- Dependable and responsible.
