
# STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE TO APPLY FOR AN ABSENTEE BALLOT ONLINE


- **STEP 1** Type the website **mnvotes.org** into the search bar for the browser
- STEP 2 Click the green letters in the middle of the page




STEP 3 Scroll down and enter your corresponding information for County, City, State, Zip Code and which election(s) you are applying for, using the drop down arrows

### What to expect now:

- For election security, the information you provided on your application will be verified. On average, this check takes 3 business days to complete.
- You will receive an email confirmation when verification is successfully completed. At that time, your application will be directed to election officials for processing.
- Once processed, you can check the status of your application and absentee ballot online.
- Remember which identification number you provided on your application (MN-issued driver's license, Minnesota ID card, or last 4 digits of Social Security Number). You will need to provide this number when you return your absentee ballot.
- · If for any reason the information you provided cannot be verified, you will receive an email about what to do next.

There is nothing else you have to do. Your application has been submitted and your ballot will be mailed to the address you provided. Detailed instructions will be sent with your ballot on how to fill out and return.
