# Trip Registration

## HOW TO SET UP YOUR ONLINE ACCOUNT

### 1 GO ONLINE

Click the blue and grey  
"Register Online" button  
Click Create Account

### 2 CREATE AN ACCOUNT

Enter information about yourself.  
Before you save, add family  
members that participate in  
recreation activities by clicking  
**Add New Member.**

### 3 SAVE

A quick approval process is  
required before your account is  
active. **A confirmation will be  
emailed when your account is  
approved.**

# Trip Registration

- Registration is open on a first-come, first-served basis
  - Online Registration opens **6:00 am on December 13** or register via **phone or in person at 10:00 am**
- Registration confirmations will be sent via email
- If trip is full, family is notified and placed on waitlist
- 2022 Season Trip Fees: **\$85/trip (includes coach bus, lift ticket + staff supervision and parent chaperone trip fees)**
- Optional ski and snowboard rental: **\$28/trip**
- One beginner ski and snowboard lesson: Free

# Withdrawal Policy

- Withdrawals must be requested at least one full week prior to the trip
- Withdrawals are only accepted by calling 763-509-5200 or emailing [recreation@plymouthmn.gov](mailto:recreation@plymouthmn.gov)
- A \$10 service fee is retained for each trip withdrawal/refund request
- There are no refunds for missed trips or for withdrawals after the stated full week policy

# Trip Cancellation

- A trip may be cancelled due to low enrollment
- The trip will be cancelled if the wind-chill is below  $-15^{\circ}$
- Weather cancellations are made Friday
  - National Weather Service forecast for trip location/time
  - Weather Channel forecast for trip location/time
  - Transportation
- Cancellations posted on Parks & Recreation Weather Line (763.509.5205) & by announcements at each school
- Full refunds issued if trip is cancelled by Parks & Recreation
- Cancellations do not result in an automatic transfer to a different trip

# Equipment Storage at School

Ski or snowboard bags are required to protect your gear

- Equipment drop off must be completed before start of school
- **Boldly label** your bag with your name and add something unique to identify your bag from others
- Coach buses have undercarriage storage for ski and snowboard equipment
- Busses will leave right after school starts, so all equipment will need to be ready to go by 3:15 pm

# Friday Nights

- Meet at Gym 9 and exit Community Doors 25 to load onto busses right after school
- Arrival to ski hill, staff gives announcements and volunteers unload equipment
- Students pick up rentals and start lessons upon arrival
- Bus loads approximately at 9:30 pm to leave ski area by 9:45 pm
- **Return to school approximately 11:00 pm**
- \* Students must be pre-registered to attend the trip
- No food or beverage on the bus
- All participants **MUST** ride the bus to and from the hill
- No use of Tobacco/Tobacco products/Vape or Alcohol at any point during the trip will be allowed

# Additional Information

- During the registration process, you will need to know your height and weight for rentals
- Students are identified by colored ribbons
- Students should wear a watch or bring a phone to always know the time
  - Set an alarm to know when to start heading in
- Procedures are in place and staff are trained for emergencies
- You must agree to the Code of Conduct upon registration

# Code of Conduct

- This is a smoke-free, alcohol-free, and drug-free club
- We expect courteous, kind, and respectful behavior
- Parents and students must sign the Code of Conduct prior to the trip
  - You sign this when you register for each trip
- All trips are Staffed and Chaperoned by adults represented by; teachers, parents and community volunteers
- All chaperones have completed a background check and training

# Tips for the Cold

- Wear a helmet – for safety + warmth
- Bring clear lens goggles
- Wear a face gaiter, hand/foot warmers, snow pants, and a warm pair of socks
- Dress in layers
- Bring a bag dinner or money for concessions at the ski areas
