A quick approval process is
required before your account is
active. **A confirmation will be
emailed when your account is
approved.**

Trip Registration

- Registration is open on a first-come, first-served basis
- Registration :
 - Register online starting at 6:00 a.m. on **December 7th**
 - Register via phone (763-509-5200) or in person at 10:00 a.m.
 - Waiver must be complete in order to attend trips. Only one waiver this year.
- Registration confirmations will be sent via email
- If trip is full, family is notified and placed on waitlist
- 2023 Season Trip Fees:
 - \$95 per trip (includes coach bus, lift ticket + staff supervision and parent chaperone trip fees)
 - Optional ski and snowboard rental is \$28 per trip
 - Additional Helmet fee (\$10)
 - One beginner ski and snowboard lesson is Free

Withdrawal Policy

- **Withdrawals must be requested at least one full week prior to the trip**
- Withdrawals are only accepted by calling 763-509-5200 or emailing recreation@plymouthmn.gov
- A \$10 service fee is retained for each trip withdrawal/refund request
- There are no refunds for missed trips or for withdrawals after the stated full week policy

Trip Cancellation

- A trip may be canceled due to low enrollment
- The trip will be canceled if the wind-chill is below -15°
- Weather cancellations are made a week prior based on:
 - National Weather Service forecast for trip location/time
 - Weather Channel forecast for trip location/time
 - Transportation
- Cancellations are on Parks & Recreation Weather Line (763.509.5205) and by announcements at each school
- Full refunds will be issued if trip is canceled by Parks & Recreation
- Cancellations do not result in an automatic transfer to a different trip

Equipment Storage

Ski or snowboard bags are required to protect your gear

- Equipment drop off must be completed before start of school
- **Boldly label your bag with your name**
- Add something unique to identify your bag from others
- Buses have undercarriage storage for ski and snowboard equipment
- Buses will leave right after school ends, so all equipment will need to be ready to go by then

Equipment Storage

Ski or snowboard bags are required to protect your gear!

Location for drop off:

- **Wayzata High School:** City of Plymouth Office near Gym 9
- **East:** Community Girls Locker Room
- **Central:** Lower Level C between Ryberg and Caspar
- **West:** Lower Level by Industrial Tech. (ETD Storage)

Ski Trip Nights

1. Meet at meeting spot and load onto buses right after school
2. Arrival to ski hill, staff gives announcements and volunteers unload equipment
3. Students pick up rentals and start lessons upon arrival
4. Bus loads approximately at 9:30 pm to leave ski area by 9:45 p.m. (Hill dependent)
5. Return to school approximately **11:00 p.m.**
 - ***Students must be pre-registered to attend the trip***
 - No food or beverage on the bus
 - All participants **MUST** ride the bus to and from the hill
 - No use of Tobacco/Tobacco products/Vape or Alcohol at any point during the trip will be allowed

Additional Information

- During the registration process, you will need to know your height and weight for rentals
- Students are identified by colored ribbons
- Students should wear a watch or bring a phone to always know the time
 - Set an alarm to know when to start heading in
- Procedures are in place and staff are trained for emergencies
- By registering, you agree to the Code of Conduct

Code of Conduct

- This is a smoke-free, alcohol-free, and drug-free club
- Courteous, kind, and respectful behavior is expected
- Parents and students must sign the Code of Conduct prior to the trip
 - You sign this when you register for each trip
- All trips are Staffed and Chaperoned by adults represented by teachers, parents, and community volunteers
 - All chaperones have completed a background check and training

Tips for the Cold

- Wear a helmet for safety + warmth
- Bring clear lens goggles
- Wear a face gaiter, hand/foot warmers, snow pants, and a warm pair of socks
- Dress in layers
- Bring a bag dinner or money for concessions at the ski areas
