#### About The NCS™

The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™) report is about the "livability" of Plymouth. A livable community is a place that is not simply habitable, but that is desirable. It is not only where people do live, but where they want to live. The survey was developed by the experts from National Research Center at Polco.

Great communities are partnerships of the government, private sector, community-based organizations and residents, all geographically connected. The NCS captures residents' opinions considering ten central facets of a community:

- Economy
- Mobility
- Community Design
- Utilities
- Safety
- Natural Environment
- Parks and Recreation
- Health and Wellness
- Education, Arts, and Culture
- Inclusivity and Engagement

The report provides the opinions of a representative sample of 555 residents of the City of Plymouth collected from August 19th, 2022 to October 7th, 2022. The margin of error around any reported percentage is 4% for all respondents and the response rate for the 2022 survey was 20%. Survey results were weighted so that the demographic profile of respondents was representative of the demographic profile of adults in Plymouth.





#### How the results are reported

For the most part, the percentages presented in the following tabs represent the "percent positive." Most commonly, the percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, etc.). On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data." However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in most of the tabs. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

#### Comparisons to benchmarks

NRC's database of comparative resident opinion is comprised of resident perspectives gathered in surveys from over 600 communities whose residents evaluated the same kinds of topics on The National Community Survey. The comparison evaluations are from the most recent survey completed in each community in the last five years. NRC adds the latest results quickly upon survey completion, keeping the benchmark data fresh and relevant. The communities in the database represent a wide geographic and population range. In each tab, Plymouth's results are noted as being "higher" than the benchmark, "lower" than the benchmark, or "similar" to the benchmark, meaning that the average rating given by Plymouth residents is statistically similar to or different (greater or lesser) than the benchmark. Being rated as "higher" or "lower" than the benchmark means that Plymouth's average rating for a particular item was more than 10 points different than the benchmark. If a rating was "much higher" or "much lower," then Plymouth's average rating was more than 20 points different when compared to the benchmark.

The survey was administered during the COVID-19 pandemic, a time of challenge for many local governments. While we provide comparisons to national benchmarks, it is important to note that much of the benchmark data was collected prior to the pandemic. This may impact how your City's 2022 ratings compare to other communities' ratings from the past five years.

### Trends over time

Trend data for Plymouth represent important comparison data and should be examined for improvements or declines\*. Deviations from stable trends over time represent opportunities for understanding how local policies, programs, or public information may have affected residents' opinions. Changes between survey years have been noted with an arrow and the percent difference. If the difference is greater than six percentage points between the 2019 and 2022 surveys, the change is statistically significant.

\* In 2020, The NCS survey was updated to include new and refreshed items. Consequently, some of the trends may be impacted due to wording modifications that could have potentially altered the meaning of the item for the respondent.

#### Methods

### Selecting survey recipients

All households within the City of Plymouth were eligible to participate in the survey. A list of all households within the zip codes serving Plymouth was purchased from Go-Dog Direct based on updated listings from the United States Postal Service. Since some of the zip codes that serve the City of Plymouth households may also serve addresses that lie outside of the community, the exact geographic location of each housing unit was compared to community boundaries using the most current municipal boundary file. Addresses located outside of the City of Plymouth boundaries were removed from the list of potential households to survey. Each address identified as being within city boundaries was further identified as being within one of the 4 areas. From that list, addresses were randomly selected as survey recipients, with multi-family housing units (defined as those with a unit number) sampled at a rate of 5:3 compared to single family housing units.

An individual within each household was selected using the birthday method. The birthday method selects a person within the household by asking the "person whose birthday has most recently passed" to complete the questionnaire. The underlying assumption in this method is that day of birth has no relationship to the way people respond to surveys. This instruction was contained in the introduction of the survey.

#### Conducting the survey

The 2,800 randomly selected households received mailings beginning on August 19th, 2022 and the survey remained open for 7 weeks. The first mailing was a postcard inviting the household to participate in the survey. The next mailing contained a cover letter with instructions, the survey questionnaire, and a postage-paid return envelope. All mailings included a web link to give residents the opportunity to respond to the survey online. All follow-up mailings asked those who had not completed the survey to do so and those who had already done so to refrain from completing the survey again.

About 2% of the 2,800 mailed invitations or surveys were returned because the household address was vacant or the postal service was unable to deliver the survey as addressed. Of the remaining 2,731 households that received the invitations to participate, 555 completed the survey, providing an overall response rate of 20%. The response rate was calculated using AAPOR's response rate #2\* for mailed surveys of unnamed persons.

It is customary to describe the precision of estimates made from surveys by a "level of confidence" and accompanying "confidence interval" (or margin of error). A traditional level of confidence, and the one used here, is 95%. The 95% confidence interval can be any size and quantifies the sampling error or imprecision of the survey results because some residents' opinions are relied on to estimate all residents' opinions. The margin of error for the City of Plymouth survey is no greater than plus or minus 4.2 percentage points around any given percent reported for all respondents (555 completed surveys).

In addition to the randomly selected "probability sample" of households, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the City of Plymouth. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it included a map at the beginning asking where the respondent lives and a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on September 23rd, 2022. The survey remained open for 2 weeks. The data presented in the following tabs exclude the open participation survey data, but a tab at the end provides the complete frequency of responses to questions by the open participation respondents.

#### Analyzing the data

Responses from mailed surveys were entered into an electronic dataset using a "key and verify" method, where all responses are entered twice and compared to each other. Any discrepancies were resolved in comparison to the original survey form. Range checks as well as other forms of quality control were also performed. Responses from surveys completed on Polco were downloaded and merged with the mailed survey responses.

The demographics of the survey respondents were compared to those found in the 2010 Census and 2020 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the City of Plymouth. The primary objective of weighting survey data is to make the survey respondents reflective of the larger population of the community. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, housing tenure, and area. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.\* The results of the weighting scheme for the probability sample are presented in the following table.

NRC aligns demographic labels with those used by the U.S. Census for reporting purposes, when possible. Some categories (e.g., age, race/Hispanic origin, housing type, and length of residency) are combined into smaller subgroups.

The survey datasets were analyzed using all or some of a combination of the Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), R, Python and Tableau. For the most part, the percentages presented in the reports represent the "percent positive." The percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, essential/very important, etc.), or, in the case of resident behaviors/participation, the percent positive represents the proportion of respondents indicating "yes" or participating in an activity at least once a month.

On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data". However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in the reports. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

### **Key Findings**

#### Safety and related services received high ratings, contributing to residents' positive quality of life.

Safety is a high priority for Plymouth residents and is rated very positively, with 94% of residents rating the overall feeling of safety in Plymouth as essential or very important for the City to focus on in the coming two years, and 84% rating it as excellent or good. While residents' ratings for the overall feeling of safety saw a slight decline since the previous iteration of the survey in 2019, this proportion was still similar to the national average.

Virtually all residents reported feeling safe in both their neighborhoods (96% very or somewhat safe) and in Plymouth's downtown/commercial area during the day (94%). Plymouth residents also appreciate the quality of safety services provided, including ambulance/EMS (97% excellent or good), police/sheriff services (91%), fire prevention and education (90%), emergency preparedness (82%), and crime prevention (80%), all of which ranked similarly to the national benchmark. Animal control, in particular, received a rating higher than the previous iteration of the survey in 2019 (a 7% increase to 88% in 2022) and was higher than the national average.

#### Plymouth residents praise their overall quality of life in the City.

Almost all residents positively rated aspects of quality of life in Plymouth, with at least 95% giving excellent or good ratings to the city as a place to live as well as the overall quality of life in Plymouth. A strong majority of residents would also recommend living in Plymouth to someone who asks (94% very or somewhat likely) and plan to remain in Plymouth for the next five years (85%). Residents value the ability to build a future in Plymouth, giving positive marks to the city as both a place to raise children (92% excellent or good) as well as a place to retire (75%). Additionally, about 7 out of 10 respondents or more reported that Plymouth does an excellent or good job making all residents feel welcome, attracting people from diverse backgrounds, valuing/respecting residents from diverse backgrounds, and taking care of vulnerable residents.

#### Residents are pleased with their local government performance.

Generally, ratings for aspects of Plymouth government performance tended to be strong and higher than those given in other communities across the nation. About 9 in 10 respondents gave excellent or good ratings to the overall customer service provided by Plymouth employees, and 85% were pleased with the overall quality of services provided by the City as well as public information services. Other public trust ratings that were especially strong included the value of services for taxes paid, City government generally acting in the best interest of the community, being honest, being open and transparent to the public, treating all residents fairly, and treating residents with respect, with at least 7 in 10 awarding high marks to each. About two-thirds of survey participants gave favorable scores to the overall direction of the City, overall confidence in Plymouth government, and informing residents about issues facing the community. While some of these ratings declined over time (where trends were available), it is noteworthy that virtually all indicators related to public trust were higher than the national benchmarks.

#### A strong economy is another feature that makes Plymouth a desirable community.

The economy is healthy in Plymouth, with an overwhelming majority of residents (91%) rating Plymouth's overall economic health as excellent or good. A similar proportion of respondents also gave favorable marks to Plymouth as a place to work, which was higher than the national average. While residents' ratings of the cost of living in Plymouth decreased slightly since the previous survey iteration, from 50% in 2019 to 43% in 2022, the vibrancy of Plymouth's downtown/commercial area trended up significantly, from 47% in 2019 to 67% in 2022. Additionally, about three-quarters of residents rated the economic development of the City positively and 7 in 10 were pleased with the overall quality of new development; both of these were higher than the national averages. Finally, the rating for employment opportunities was higher than the previous iteration of the survey in 2019 (an 8% increase to 81% in 2022) and was much higher than the national average.

## Plymouth residents highly value their natural environment and the recreational opportunities available to them.

About 9 in 10 survey respondents gave excellent or good ratings to the overall quality of the natural environment in Plymouth (which was similar to the national average) and to the cleanliness of the city, water resources, and air quality (which were higher than average). About 9 in 10 residents also indicated satisfaction with the overall quality of parks and recreation opportunities in Plymouth and overall health and wellness opportunities, as well as City parks, availability of paths and walking trails, recreation programs or classes, and recreation centers or facilities. Ratings for natural environment, parks, and recreation tended to be similar to or higher than national averages and similar to those given in previous survey years. Finally, in a survey question unique to Plymouth, when asked how important they thought it was for the community to focus on various strategic planning areas in the next three years, about two-thirds of respondents rated the walkability and bikeability of Plymouth as essential or very important.

## **Facets of livability**

Resident perceptions of quality and importance for each of the facets of community livability provide an overview of community strengths and challenges that are useful for planning, budgeting and performance evaluation.

The charts below show the proportion of residents who rated the community facets positively for quality and the priority (importance) placed on each. Also displayed is whether local ratings were lower, similar, or higher than communities across the country (the national benchmark).

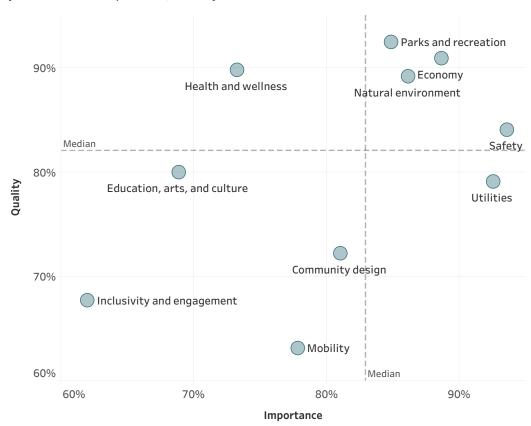
#### **Balancing performance and importance**

Every jurisdiction must balance limited resources while meeting resident needs and striving to optimize community livability. To this end, it is helpful to know what aspects of the community are most important to residents and which they perceive as being of higher or lower quality. It is especially helpful to know when a facet of livability is considered of high importance but rated as lower quality, as this should be a top priority to address.

To help guide City staff and officials with decisions on future resource allocation, resident ratings of the importance of services were compared to their ratings of the quality of these services. To identify the services perceived by residents to have relatively lower quality at the same time as relatively higher importance, all services were ranked from highest perceived quality to lowest perceived quality and from highest perceived importance to lowest perceived importance. Some services were in the top half of both lists (higher quality and higher importance); some were in the top half of one list but the bottom half of the other (higher quality and lower importance or lower quality and higher importance); and some services were in the bottom half of both lists.

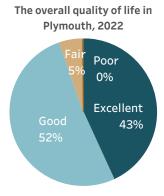
Services receiving quality ratings of excellent or good by 82% or more of respondents were considered of "higher quality" and those with ratings lower than 82% were considered to be of "lower quality." Services were classified as "more important" if they were rated as essential or very important by 83% or more of respondents. Services were rated as "less important" if they received a rating of less than 83%. This classification uses the median ratings for quality and importance to divide the services in half.

The quadrants in the figure below show which community facets were given higher or lower importance ratings (right-left) and which had higher or lower quality ratings (up-down). Facets of livability falling closer to a diagonal line from the lower left to the upper right are those where performance ratings are more commensurate with resident priorities. Facets scoring closest to the lower right hand corner of the matrix (higher in importance and lower in quality) are those that may warrant further investigation to see if changes to their delivery are necessary to improve their performance. This is the key part of this chart on which to focus. Facets falling in the top left hand corner of the chart (lower in importance but higher in quality) are areas where performance may outscore resident priorities, and may be a consideration for lower resource allocation.

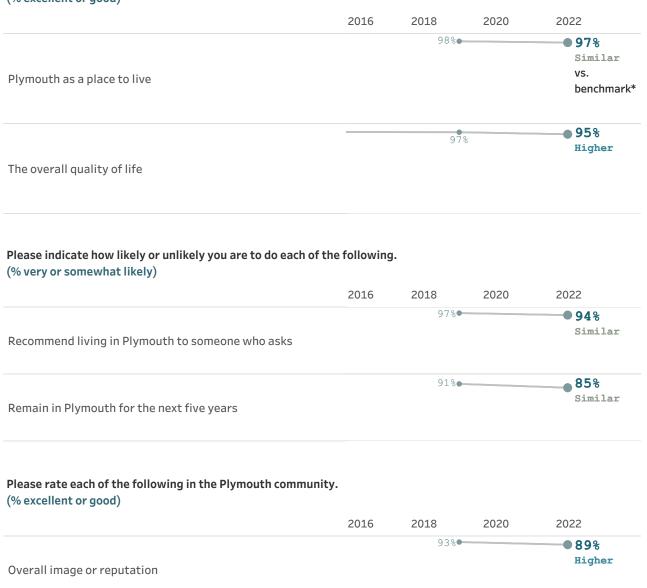

Measuring community livability starts with assessing the quality of life of those who live there, and ensuring that the community is attractive, accessible, and welcoming to all.



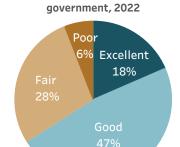
Please rate each of the following aspects of quality of life in Plymouth. (% excellent or good)

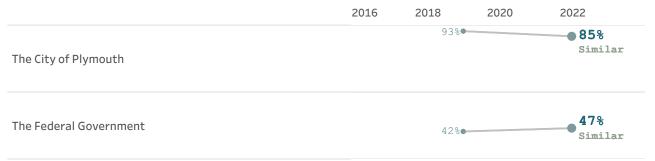

## Overall, how would you rate the quality of the services provided by each of the following? (% excellent or good)



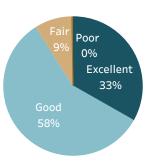

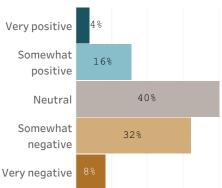

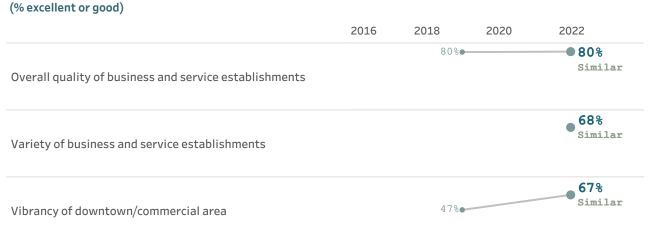

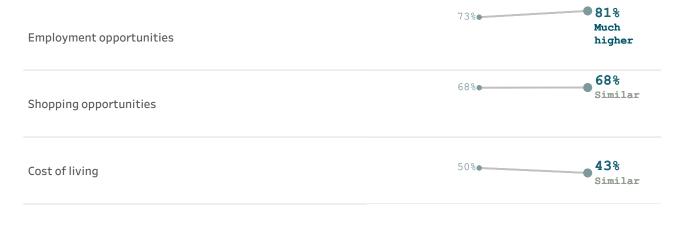

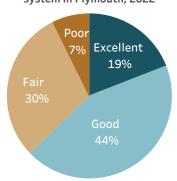

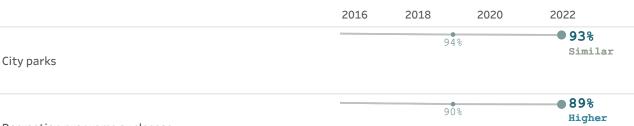

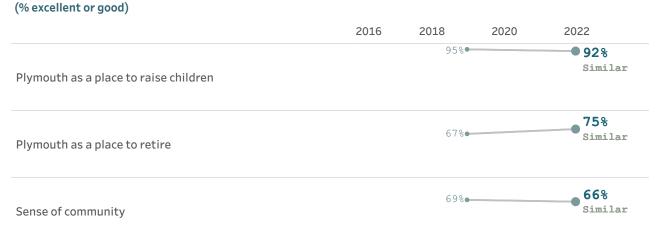

## Methods (open participation)

As part of its participation in The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™), the City of Plymouth conducted a survey of 2,800 residents. Survey invitations were mailed to randomly selected households and data were collected from August 19th, 2022 to October 7th, 2022. The results from this main survey effort represent the most robust estimate of your residents' opinions.

After the above data collection period was underway, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the City of Plymouth. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it included a map at the beginning asking where the respondent lives and also a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on September 23th, 2022. The survey remained open for 2 weeks and there were 595 responses.

The open participation survey data were not collected through a random sample and it is unknown who in the community was aware of the survey; therefore, a level of confidence in the representativeness of the sample cannot be estimated. However, to reduce bias where possible, these data were statistically weighted to match the demographic characteristics of the 2010 Census and 2020 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the City of Plymouth. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, housing tenure, and area. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.\* The results of the weighting scheme for the open participation survey are presented in the following table.
