#### NATIONAL COMMUNITY SURVEY

- National Research Center
  - POWERED BY POLCO
  - Polco

- Plymouth first conducted the NCS in 2019
- 2022: scientific sample of 2,800 randomly selected households
  - Mailed survey, with option to take it online instead
  - Survey responses accepted for 7 weeks (Aug. 19 through Oct. 7)
  - 20% response rate, 2% of surveys returned due to vacancy/USPS inability to deliver mail
  - 95% level of confidence (+/- 4% margin of error)
- Benchmarking survey
- Results weighted to reflect the population of the community



### **OPEN PARTICIPATION ONLINE SURVEY**

- Supplemental online option open to all residents
- Available for 2 weeks: Sept. 23 through Oct. 7
- 595 responses
- Complete report included in packet

#### Plymouth residents invited to participate in community survey by Oct. 7

The City of Plymouth is conducting a communitywide survey – and residents are invited to participate. The deadline to complete the survey is Friday, Oct. 7.

The city has partnered with Polco/the National Research Center to conduct the survey, which is aimed at collecting community feedback and gauging city service satisfaction. The survey includes questions about quality of life, public safety, customer satisfaction and more.

# Community-wide survey underway

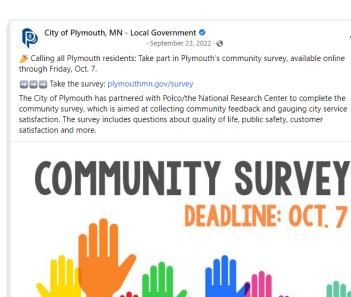
In an effort to collect community feedback and gauge city service satisfaction, the City of Plymouth is working with Polco/the National Research Center to complete a community survey. The survey includes questions about quality of life, public safety, customer satisfaction and more.

Surveys have been mailed to 2,800 randomly selected households in Plymouth. Those households received a mailing in mid-August notifying them that they were selected to participate in the survey.

Residents not a part of the randomly selected group will also have the opportunity to fill out a survey online at plymouthmn.gov/survey, which will be available Sept. 23 through Oct. 7.

Results will be presented to the City Council at a future meeting and published online at plymouthmn.gov/survey.

Community surveys will be completed every three years. Consistent surveys allow the city to assess changes in resident input and encourage data-driven, evidence-based decision making.

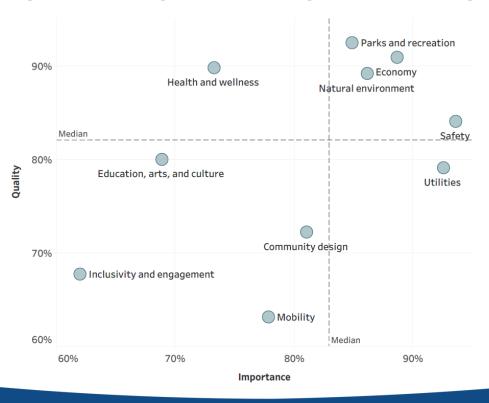

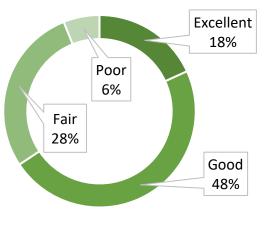

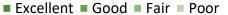

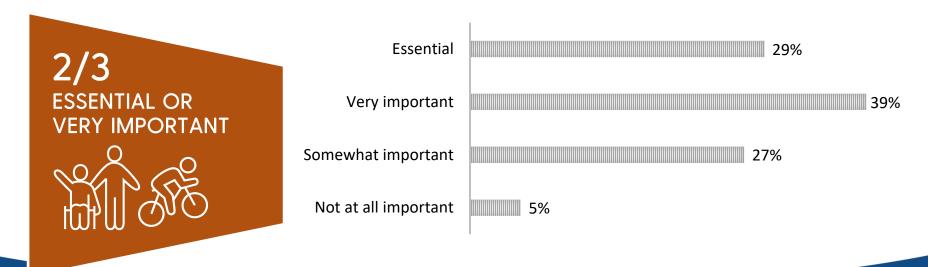

Please rate how important it is for the Plymouth community to focus on each of the following in the coming three years.

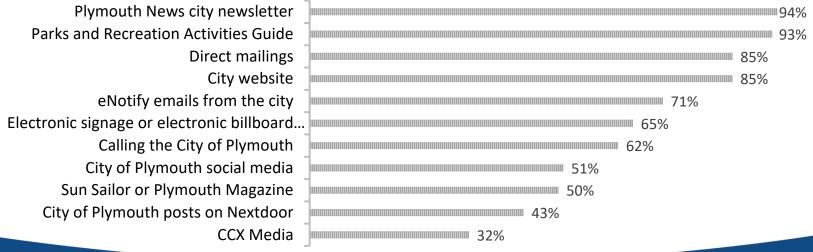

How much of a source are each the following for obtaining information about the city government and its activities, events, and services? (% major or minor source)

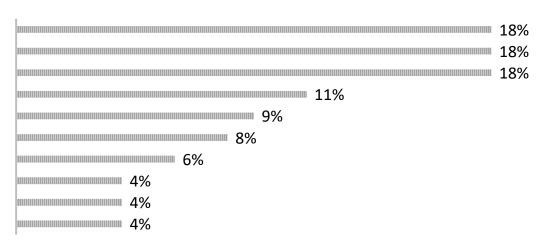
