The proposed improvements for the Station 73 TRIP include the following:

- Reconstruction of approximately 3,000 feet of Highway 55
- Construction of new bus stops on eastbound and westbound Highway 55
- Construction of a trail underpass across Highway 55
- Re-alignment of County Road 73 from Highway 55 toSunset Trail
- Construction of a roundabout at the County Road 73 and Sunset Trail intersection
- Reconstruction of approximately 1,500 feet of South Shore Drive and 10th Avenue
 - Construction of a roundabout at the South Shore Drive and 10th Avenue intersection
 - Construction of approximately 1.2 miles of Eagle
 Lake Regional Trail from Luce Line Trail to 1st
 Avenue North and construction of other sidewalks
 - Site improvements at the Station 73 transit center
 - Stormwater and utility improvements within the project limits
