


General Fund Revenue - 2023 Budget








General Fund Expenditures - 2023 Budget







Tax Levy History 2014-2023










Tax Rate History Hennepin Cities Over 45,000








Residential Property (\$440,000) Tax Distribution 2023




Commercial Property (\$1,000,000) Tax Distribution 2023









Market Value % by Class 2023 Payable in 2024























Metro Fiscal Disparities Program - Top Six Winners and Losers in 2023








Net Dollars Lost to Fiscal Disparities


















Gross Business Sales by City



Statutory Debt Limit Versus Actual Debt






City of Plymouth Levies for Tax Supported Debt








Tax Increment Captured As % of Total Tax Base (2023)








Plymouth Tax Rate History Projections versus Actuals










Direct Net Debt Per Capita



City Portion Only





Direct Net Debt as % of Market Value City Portion Only












Households (Thousands)


