## COACH-PITCH BASEBALL RULES

1. Games will last up to three/four innings. Players arriving late will be added to the end of the batting order.
2. No more than 10 players in the field at a time – no team should have over 10 players. Teams use an unlimited batting order – all players bat. All outfielders should stand on the grass. No more than five infielders, not including pitcher and catcher. We will try to have the children experience playing a variety of different defensive positions during the season. **Use throw-down bases for this level (approx. – 60 ft)**
3. Each team will bat until all players have batted. Last batter runs all bases, unless tagged out. Even if defense makes out play, runner stays on the base.
4. After 6 pitches, please utilize the “T” for the child to bat. The next time up to plate, try pitches again to give the kids a chance to improve and use “T” again if needed.
5. Please stress to the kids to drop bat before running and not throwing bat.
6. For the batting team, all players must remain on the bench until it's their turn to bat.
7. Maximum of 2 bases at a time – hit in grass on fly 2 bases, hit in the infield 1 base. Last game, if defense gets player out – the player is out and does not run the base. After 3 outs – bases are cleared. Still bat complete lineup.
8. Coaches pitch to the kids at their level (kneel down while pitching) use extra base to protect knee from infield dirt.
9. No bunting or stealing.
10. Teams should shake hands / high five the opposing team after each game.
11. **Only the batter at the plate is allowed to have a bat in their hands.**
