

# 36th Avenue Rehabilitation Project

November 2023 Open House Engagement Summary



## Open House

The first public Open House was held November 8, 2023 from 5:00-6:30 pm at Plymouth Middle School. This meeting shared and collected feedback on the proposed improvements to address additional traffic flow and pedestrian safety concerns. The public feedback period began on November 8 and closed on November 22. All meeting materials and feedback opportunities were also posted on the project website.

## Next Steps

Now, through November 2024, the final design will be developed based on the last round of feedback gathered. Bidding and project approvals will take place December 2024 through April 2025. A public hearing is anticipated to take place at this time. Lastly, construction is planned for May through November 2025.

## COMMENT THEMES



▪ **West access:** shift the median/crossing location to the west side to allow a turn lane for westbound traffic.

▪ **East access:** ensure there is a left turn lane into the lot for westbound traffic.

▪ Request for a crosswalk and pedestrian refuge.

▪ Request for a dedicated right turn lane.  
▪ Request for flashing lights at stop sign to increase visibility and compliance.

▪ Request for dedicated right turn lane to Lancaster due to high traffic to apartments in the area.  
▪ Request for a roundabout.  
▪ *A roundabout is less desirable as its increased capacity is unnecessary and it's inconsistent with nearby signalized intersections.*  
▪ Concern with buses ability to make a left turn from Lancaster onto 36th.
