


General Fund Revenues – 2024 Budget








General Fund Expenditures – 2024 Budget








City of Plymouth Employees Per 1,000 Population







City of Plymouth Tax Levy History 2015-2024





Average Tax Rate from 2015 - 2024 = 26.18%





















Tax Rate History Hennepin County Suburbs > 45,000 Population








Residential Property Tax Distribution - 2024

(Median value of \$470,000)




Commercial Property Tax Distribution - 2024

(Sample property value of \$5 million)






Market Value % by Class 2023 Payable in 2024




Tax Capacity % by Class 2023 Payable in 2024

















Total Taxable Market Value As Percentage of Total County Market Value Hennepin County Suburbs > 45,000 Population








City of Plymouth Residential Building Permits 20011 - 2023










Metro Fiscal Disparities Program - Top Six Winners and Losers in 2024



City of Plymouth Net Dollars Lost to Fiscal Disparities









Employment in Plymouth (Jobs)





Gross Business Sales by City



Statutory Debt Limit Versus Actual Debt




City of Plymouth Levies for Current Tax Supported Debt








Tax Increment Captured Hennepin County Cities > 10,000 Population As % of Total Tax Base (2024)







Levy Per Capita Hennepin County Suburbs > 45,000 Population



2024 Levy Per Capita Comparison Hennepin County Cities > 10,000 Population







Debt Service as % of Operating Expenses Hennepin County Suburbs > 45,000 Population





Direct Net Debt as % of Market Value Hennepin County Suburbs > 45,000 Population


