## To calculate the utility allowance for a unit:

- 1. Circle the unit type that you are looking at;
- 2. For any utility that the tenant pays, circle the amount listed in the appropriate column;
- 3. Only circle "stove" or "fridge" if the tenant supplies those appliances in the unit;
- 4. The total of all circled numbers is the utility allowance for that unit;
- 5. Use the utility allowance for THE SMALLER OF your voucher size or the unit size (for example, if you have a 2 bedroom voucher but are looking at a 3 bedroom unit, calculate the 2 bedroom utility allowance)
