PROJECT SCHEDULE

On Tuesday, June 10, crews plan to begin Phase 2 of work, which will close 36th Avenue from the east entrance of the Armstrong High School to Kilmer Lane. At this time, the Phase 1 area will reopen (36th Avenue from Zachary Lane to the east entrance of Armstrong High School) while the contractor completes work behind the curbs and along the shoulders of 36th Avenue.

During the Phase 2 closure, access to Plymouth Middle School will be maintained while work occurs in their parking lots and in front of the school along 36th Avenue. Drivers will use Lancaster Lane and Pilgrim Lane to access the school's newly aligned west driveway. Drivers will use the gravel driveway to enter and exit the school during this phase.

As a reminder, 36th Avenue is planned to fully reopen before school starts in fall 2025. Construction will continue behind the curbs into the fall which may include sidewalks, trails, signage, signal systems, and landscaping. Construction is expected to be completed by the end of October 2025.
