Welcome to the 4th Newsletter and Schedule for 2025

Hard to believe we are coming to the end of the 2025 Pedalers season! Overall, the weather has been favorable, with only a few rides rained out. The past seven weeks saw the Lite group visiting the Sculpture Garden in Minneapolis, and riding out on trails to Elm Creek, Excelsior, and the Carver Park Nature Center. The Regular group enjoyed several new rides, venturing to the Japanese Gardens in Bloomington, exploring Carver Park, and visiting the historic Highland Water Tower.















Our 4th schedule has the Lite group heading to varied locations in the metro, including the Coon Rapids Dam, Fort Snelling, Pryes Brewery, and the Cannon Valley Trail. The Regular group will take in the Graffiti Murals in Minneapolis, Baker Park Reserve, Fort Snelling, and experience the Great Northern Railroad trail from Elk River to Zimmerman, as well as an early October route to Stillwater to view fall colors along the St. Croix River.

Lite Riders ride on Wednesdays only. The Regular Group riders have the option to ride on Monday and/or Wednesday. The Monday ride may be more exploratory, checking for trail closures and alternate routes. The Monday ride will have the same start time and location as the Wednesday ride. The "Ride Cancellation Info Line" will be available on Monday and both Wednesday rides.

Ride Cancellation Info Line

Our announcement line is 763-509-5205. On ride days, the announcement will be updated by 7:30 a.m. only if the ride is cancelled. Call the info line if in doubt about the weather so you don't drive to a ride and find out it was cancelled.

Start Times

Rides on the 4th schedules generally start at 9:30. The exceptions are the Lite rides on September 17th and October 8th, and the Regular rides on October 6th, 8th, and 13th, which all start at 10:00. Please check the schedule closely!
