- The Adult Division is open to artists 18 years and older
- The Teen Division is open to high school students in grades 9-12 during the 2013-2014 school year
- Designs must be original; created by the applicant
- Submit a scale color design of vertical banner on 6" wide x 12" long paper
- Include a non-refundable entry fee of:
  - \$20 Adult Division (covers two banner designs)
  - \$15 Teen Division (covers two banner designs)
- Make check payable to **The Plymouth Arts Council.**
- Entry deadline is **Wednesday, February 20, 2014, 4 p.m.** (submissions will not be returned)
- If design(s) is selected as one of the top three in your division, artist will provide paints/materials to apply design(s) on one side of a 2' x 4' paper banner(s) which is provided by PAC
- Completed banner(s) must be delivered to the Parks & Recreation Department at the City Hall by **Wednesday, April 2, 2014, 4 p.m.**
